RESTORATIVE PROCEDURES Veneers (Impression)


Veneers cover the front surface of a tooth, and are typically done to improve the appearance of a patient's smile. Veneers usually require multiple appointments to complete.

At your first appointment, your doctor will take an impression of your teeth. A dental laboratory will create a model of your mouth, which will be used to create your temporary and final veneers.

During your next visit, your teeth are prepared for the veneers.

A second impression is taken, and temporary veneers are placed over your teeth until the final ones are ready.


At a following appointment, your doctor will remove the temporary veneers, and bond the final veneers into place.




